Pack Overnight Camping

Pack Overnights are pack-organized overnight events, involving more than one family from a single Pack, focused on age-appropriate Cub Scout activities and conducted at council-approved locations.

At least one adult on a pack overnighter must have completed **Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO)** to properly understand the importance of program intent, Youth Protection policies, health and safety, site selection, age-appropriate activities, and sufficient adult participation.

PROCESS FOR GETTING A SITE APPROVED:

Any unit leader can get a site approved by inspecting and evaluating the site, filling out the “Pack Overnighter Site Approval Form,” and submitting it to the Council Service Center to the attention of the Cub Scout Camping Committee Staff Advisor. You will be notified when the campsite has been approved; the site information will also be posted on the Council website. Further information about each of the approved sites can be found on the Council website under Cub Camping.

The Council relies on individual units to inspect and evaluate sites they wish to visit; a Scout is trustworthy and everyone’s primary concern is the safety of our Scouts. **The unit wishing to visit the site does the inspection and evaluation; the Council keeps a record of sites that have passed the evaluation.** Each site must be re-inspected every two years.

For insurance purposes, it is essential that every site your Pack utilizes is an approved site. If an incident occurs at a site that is not logged as having been evaluated and approved by the Council the BSA will not be able to help the unit in addressing the situation.
