What Is Apple Harvest?

This is the Monticello District Fall Boy Scout Camporee and Cub Scout Fun Day. There is always a theme- and this year the main theme will be “Gladiator Games”. Cub Scouts will get to spend the afternoon doing all types of activities and Gladiator related Fun!!

The **Field Day** will start with a flag ceremony at 1:30pm. Cub Scouts will then move from station to station together with the rest of their pack or den, supervised by their leaders and parents. They move at their own pace. Some stations may have a wait – decide how you want to spend your time, but try to get around to all the stations. The **Root Beer Social** will be at 4:30pm

APPLE HARVEST 5K TRAIL RUCK AND RUN– Our Scouts have been participating in a 5K run for the past few years and this year we are adding a new event, a Ruck Run. Scouts can now choose between running a 5-kilometer course, or carrying their back packs and hiking a different 5-kilometer course. We are inviting the rest of the District, as well the Community, to come and participate! We are using this event to raise money for our Scouting Program- and **We Need Your Help!!** Invite your family, friends, neighbors, and colleagues. Registration is on-line only- and the cost is \$20/runner for adults and \$10.00 for youth runners. The race starts at 8am (check-in starts at 7am) Shirts are available, but only by pre-order. No shirts will be available to buy the day of the race.

CHECK-IN PROCESS

Check-in: Saturday, October 12, 2019, 12:30-1:30pm Cub Leaders can check in their entire pack or den.

Late arrivals are no problem – just have them join you where you are. Patches will be distributed at check-in.

CAMPOREE PATCHES

All registered Cub Scouts will receive a camporee patch. Additional camporee patches may be available for \$3.00 - while supplies last.

COVERED CRAFT ACTIVITIES

ALL Craft and table activities will take place either under the Pole Barn or under large tents to make sure Cubs will not be adversely affected in the event of rain.

“ROCKETS IN SCOUTING”

New Cub Scouts who have joined a Pack during the Fall Recruitment can bring their “ticket” to the Camporee to exchange for a model rocket to build and launch. Also bring a friend and his family to Apple Harvest! - have him join scouts that day, pay BSA registration fee of \$24 and he will receive a rocket to build and shoot. All existing Scouts will also be able to shoot rockets!!

DIRECTIONS TO THE CAMPOREE

271 Pleasant Grove Drive, Palmyra, VA 22963

Take I-64 East to the Zion Crossroads exit. Turn right and go South on Rt. 15. Pass Rt. 250 and continue into Palmyra. Cross the Rivanna River Bridge. Turn right onto Rt. 53. Pleasant Grove is about 2 miles up on the right. Look for the camporee sign.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Cub Scouts will not be able to participate in any Boy Scout events.
- No pets will be allowed at the camporee.
- All Scouts and families should practice Leave No Trace (“LNT”) principles! **Please pack-out all of your trash.**
- NO Potable water will be available on-site. Bring your water bottle full.
- Stay out of wooded areas.

FIRST AID

First aid will be available at the camporee. Come to Headquarters if you have ANY injuries.

“BE PREPARED”

Be sure to come prepared for an exciting day! Check the weather report. If needed- bring rain gear, umbrellas, and/or suntan lotion. Don't forget water bottles and snacks.

with an adult parent/guardian will be able to camp onsite Saturday Night **with** a sponsoring troop- WEATHER PERMITTING! **Youth Protection Policy for boy/girl camping will need to be followed!!**

Scouts/parents/leaders need to **make contact with the sponsoring troop prior to the event! Check-in for overnight camping must be completed by the scout/parent- starting at 4:30pm on Saturday at HQ.**
